



## ICB TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP POLICY 2024

### For Students in Years 5-12 in 2025

#### Introduction

The Islamic College of Brisbane (ICB) is dedicated to nurturing well-rounded individuals and fostering excellence, not only in academics but also in technology. In line with this commitment, the ICB Technology Scholarship is a one-year opportunity open to students from Years 5 to 12 who exhibit exceptional technology abilities and are interested in enrolling at the school.

The Technology Scholarship program at the Islamic College of Brisbane seeks to recognize and reward outstanding technological achievements. This document outlines the criteria, application process, and terms associated with the Scholarship.

#### Eligibility / Scholarship Criteria

The Technology Scholarship is available to students from Years 5 to 12, whether currently enrolled at ICB or seeking admission from other schools. This scholarship provides a percentage reduction in tuition and competition fees based on the applicant's demonstrated technological prowess and achievements in the areas of Robotics, and/or Cybersecurity. Students showcasing exceptional skills and dedication in their chosen technology area will be considered for this scholarship.

#### Scholarship Percentages:

All scholarships will cover a percentage of Students Tuition and competition fees in their chosen Technology area. The College will offer a maximum of:

- 2x 100% Scholarships
- 2x 75% Scholarships
- 2x 50% Scholarships
- 4x 25% Scholarships

#### Application Process

To apply for the Technology Scholarship, students must follow these steps:

1. Submission of Application Form: Complete and submit the official scholarship application form, available on the school's official website. Ensure timely submission within the specified deadline.
2. Technology Achievements: Provide documentation highlighting technological achievements, including certificates, awards, and any relevant accolades. Submit as much supporting



evidence as possible to showcase the student's dedication and excellence in their chosen Technology area.

3. **Teacher/Coach Recommendation:** Obtain a recommendation letter from the student's current technology teacher/coach. This letter should highlight the student's commitment, skills, and potential in their chosen technology area.
4. **Additional Documents:** Include the following additional documents:
  - Copy of the student's, father's, and mother/guardian's Identity Card or Passport (both sides are required).
  - Copy of the student's birth certificate.
  - One recent colour passport-size photograph of the student, father, and mother/guardian.
  - Australian Citizenship Certificates or any relevant visas covering the student.

### **Evaluation Process**

A scholarship committee, appointed by the school, will review all scholarship applications and assess the technological abilities of the candidates. The committee aims to ensure fairness and transparency throughout the evaluation process.

### **Closing Date**

The technology scholarship applications will close on **Friday the 1<sup>st</sup> of November 2024**.

### **Notification**

Successful Technology Scholarship recipients will receive notifications from the school administration. Unsuccessful applicants will also be informed.

### **Scholarship Terms**

- a) Scholarship recipients must maintain a high standard of technological performance during the scholarship period.
- b) Recipients are expected to actively participate in school technology activities (Robotics/Cybersecurity) and maintain excellent conduct.
- c) The scholarship is subject to an annual review, and recipients must reapply for the scholarship for the next academic year.
- d) Non-compliance with scholarship terms or inadequate performance may result in the revocation of the scholarship.

### **Review**

This scholarship policy will undergo regular review and updates by the school administration to ensure fairness and relevance.
