



ICB SENIOR SECONDARY ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP POLICY 2027 (For students entering Year 11 in 2027)

Introduction

The Islamic College of Brisbane (ICB) is committed to promoting academic excellence and nurturing well-rounded individuals. The ICB Academic Scholarship program provides two-year scholarships (Years 11 and 12) to students who demonstrate exceptional academic ability.

This policy outlines the eligibility requirements, application process, evaluation procedures, and terms of the ICB Secondary Academic Scholarship.

Eligibility / Scholarship Criteria

The Secondary School Academic Scholarship is available to current Year 10 students who display outstanding academic achievement.

Students may apply for the scholarship in 2026; however, **final eligibility will be confirmed at the end of 2026 or beginning of 2027 based on the student's overall GPA.**

- Scholarships will be awarded to applicants with the **highest GPAs**, according to the number of scholarships available.
- To retain the scholarship across both years, recipients must maintain strong academic performance.

Application Process

To apply for the ICB Academic Scholarship, students must complete the following steps:

1. Submission of Application Form

Applicants must complete and submit the official scholarship application form, available on the school's website, by the advertised deadline.

2. Academic Documentation

Applicants must provide:

- Copies of the past two years of school reports (non-ICB applicants).
- Year 9 NAPLAN results.
- ICAS certificates, school achievement awards, or other relevant academic documentation.
- Students are encouraged to submit as many supporting documents as possible to demonstrate academic excellence.



3. Teacher Recommendation

recommendation letter must be submitted by a current teacher. Applicants should request this from a teacher at their school.

4. Additional Documents

Non-ICB applicants must provide the following:

- Copies (both sides) of the identity cards or passports of the student and parents/guardians.
- The student's birth certificate.
- One recent passport-size photograph of the student and each parent/guardian.
- Proof of Australian citizenship or relevant visas.

Evaluation Process

A scholarship committee appointed by the school will:

- Review all applications and supporting documents,
- Ensure transparency, fairness, and consistency throughout the evaluation process.

Notification

Both successful and unsuccessful applicants will be formally notified by the school administration after all evaluations are completed.

Scholarship Terms

Recipients of the ICB Secondary Academic Scholarship must adhere to the following conditions:

- a) Maintain a high standard of academic performance throughout the scholarship period.
- b) Participate positively in school activities and maintain exemplary conduct.
- c) The scholarship is subject to **annual review**. Students must continue to meet the academic criteria to retain their scholarship for the following year.
- d) The scholarship may be revoked if academic performance declines or if the student fails to comply with scholarship expectations.

Review

This policy will be reviewed periodically by the school administration to ensure fairness, relevance, and alignment with school values and academic standards.
