



## Islamic College of Brisbane (ICB) Junior Secondary Scholarship Program Year 7 Entry Scholarships for Year 6 Students

### Commitment to Excellence

The Islamic College of Brisbane (ICB) is committed to providing educational opportunities while supporting students who demonstrate integrity, dedication, achievement, and a strong commitment to learning.

The ICB Junior Secondary Academic Scholarship Program reflects the College's belief in empowering students during the early years of secondary education to achieve their full potential and contribute meaningfully to both the school community and wider society.

### Eligibility

The Junior Secondary Academic Scholarship is open to current Year 6 students applying for enrolment into Year 7 at the Islamic College of Brisbane. The Scholarship is valid in Year 7 only.

Applicants are expected to meet the College's enrolment eligibility requirements. (Please contact the enrolment officer if you are unsure)

### Selection Process

The scholarship selection process is designed to provide a fair and holistic assessment of each applicant. Selection is based on academic merit, interview performance, and consideration of a student's overall achievements and character.

#### 1: ACER Scholarship Test

All applicants are required to complete the ACER (Australian Council for Educational Research) Scholarship Test conducted at the Islamic College of Brisbane during Term 3.

The assessment includes:

- English Comprehension
- Mathematics
- Written Expression

The assessment is independently marked by ACER, and shortlisted applicants will be identified based on the results achieved.

#### 2: Interview

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to participate in an interview with members of the College Leadership Team.

The interview process provides an opportunity for students to discuss their educational values, achievements, interests, aspirations, and involvement in extracurricular or community activities.



Applicants will be assessed on communication skills, confidence, presentation, critical thinking, and overall suitability for the scholarship program.

### **3: Review of Academic and Extracurricular Achievement**

ICB may also consider additional information including school reports, NAPLAN results, ICAS results (if available), extracurricular achievements, community involvement, and demonstrated behaviour and attitude towards learning.

### **Scholarship Award**

Scholarships will be awarded to students who demonstrate outstanding performance across the ACER Scholarship Test, interview process, and achievement review.

Scholarships are determined at the discretion of the College. Scholarships offer partial tuition fee remission of up to 50%

### **Conditions of Scholarship**

ICB Scholarship recipients must maintain the following standards and expectations throughout the scholarship period:

- Maintain a high standard of academic effort and achievement
- Demonstrate respectful and positive behaviour and conduct
- Align with the values and expectations of ICB
- Model positive participation in the wider aspects of the College

Failure to maintain these expectations may result in the scholarship being reviewed or withdrawn at the discretion of the College.

### **Notification of Outcome**

All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their scholarship application via email following the completion of the selection process.

### **Policy Review**

This policy will be reviewed periodically by the College Leadership Team to ensure it remains fair, transparent, and aligned with the values and strategic direction of the Islamic College of Brisbane.
